Source	Something that tells us about history. These can be primary or secondary.	Compare how humans lived at the start and the end of the Stone Age. To start, humans lived separately and at the end they lived in settlements and farmed animals.
Stone Age	The earliest known period of human history.	Describe the Bronze Age. The Bronze Age is when humans started to use metal. Describe farming, religion and art and culture.
Bronze Age	The period of time between the Stone Age and Iron Age.	What changed in the Iron Age? The Iron-age is when tools and weapons became more advanced and were used for farming.
Iron Age	The period of time after the Bronze Age.	What is Skara Brae? A Stone Age village preserved in Scotland.
Domesticate	Keep an animal tame or kept as a pet or on a farm.	
Settlement	A place that people establish a community and stay in one place.	
Prehistory	A period of time before written records.	
Artefact	An object such as a tool that was made in the past and found in the present.
