Iron Age	The period of time after the Bronze Age.		The Bronze Age is when humans started to use metal. Describe farming, religion and art and culture.
Domesticate	Keep an animal tame or kept as a pet or on a farm.		What changed in the Iron Age?
Settlement	A place that people establish a community and stay in one place.		The Iron-age is when tools and weapons became more advanced and were used for farming.
Prehistory	A period of time before written records.		What is Skara Brae?
Artefact	An object such as a tool that was made in the past and found in the present.		A Stone Age village preserved in Scotland.
