Explorer	Someone who goes on a journey to find out about somewhere or something new.		I know what an explorer is and name some significant explorers from history.
Jungle	An area of land overgrown with dense forest and tangled vegetation.		I know that different environments have different features and can talk about these.
Mountain	A large natural elevation of the earth's surface rising abruptly from the surrounding ground.		I can talk about similarities and differences between Scunthorpe and different environments e.g. weather and houses.
Ocean	A very large expanse of sea.		I can name different objects and say which materials they are made out of.
Polar	Describes anything about (or near) the North Pole or South Pole.		I know that some materials float and some sink and that this depends on their properties.
Desert	A waterless, desolate area of land with little or no vegetation, typically one covered with sand.		I can name some common explorer equipment and talk about how it is used.
Climate	The long-term weather conditions.		I can talk about features that you might see in the different environments and compare them to my own.
Environment	The surroundings in which a person, animal, or plant lives.		I can talk about the different vehicles and modes of transport used and why they are suitable for their environments.
Similarities	Where something is almost the same as something else.		I can look at a simple map and recognise some features.
Difference	Where something is not like something else.		I know the difference between physical and human features in the environment.
